

Stars of Louisville

Hampshire Sale

Following are the rules for entries into the Stars of Louisville Hampshire Sale.

- The Stars of Louisville Hampshire Sale will be held Saturday, November 11th at 6:00 PM. The show will precede the sale at approximately 5:00 PM. Consignors do not need to be exhibitors at the North American International Livestock Expo to enter this sale.
- There will be a show, judged by TBD, prior to the sale to establish sale order.
- Consignors may reserve the right to show any sale animal in the National Hampshire Show, Tuesday, November 14th at 8:00 AM. Any sheep retained for show by the consignor will be released to the buyer immediately after the conclusion of the show. The consignor must announce that show rights are being retained when the animal is selling. Transportation of any retained show animals will be arranged by the buyer and seller.
- Classes offered are Fitted Yearling Ewes, Slick Shorn Yearling Ewes, Fitted Senior Ewe Lambs, Slick Shorn Senior Ewe Lambs, Fitted January, February and March Ewe Lambs and Slick Shorn January, February and March Ewe Lambs. This will be the show order.
- Ewes selling as bred will be sonogrammed at the seller's expense and those results will be announced.
- All consignments must be accompanied by a health paper which meets the requirements of the State of Kentucky. A separate health paper is required for each animal. Note that the consignee on your health paper should be the Stars of Louisville Hampshire Sale.
- An entry fee of \$25 per head must accompany your entries. A 11% commission of the selling price will be deducted from your sale settlement.
- All sheep must be registered and the registration papers must be turned into sale management prior to the show. Transfer fees will be deducted from the consignors settlement check.
- Entry deadline is September 20, 2017. Mail all entries to AHSA, PO Box 231, Wamego, KS 66547, or email entries to asregistry@gmail.com.

- The catalog will be printed in the fall issue of the Hampshire Heartbeat. We encourage consignors to submit a digital photo of each entry to include in the catalog.
